

GUSTIN TOWNSHIP - ALCONA COUNTY

The Regular Meeting of the Gustin Township Board was called to order in the Village of Lincoln, August 15, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor Brege.

Present: Supervisor Brege, Treasurer Leeseberg, Clerk LaVergne, Trustee Goddard and Trustee Ginder. Guests: Assessor Somers and Al Scully.

Motion by Goddard, seconded by Leeseberg to approve the agenda as presented.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Al Scully discussed with the board the community service project the Lions Club was doing this year. They would like to place 6x8 signs in the North, South and West sides of Lincoln, possibly one being in Gustin Township. He asked about the zoning of the township and Supervisor Brege looked into it at the meeting. He will let the township know if it ends up being on township property. On behalf of him being a Commissioner he thanked the township from the road commission for keeping up the township roads. He noted that the crew of the road commission was less but he feels they are getting more done. He noted the 10 hour days helped in the summer for projects.

Motion by Brege, seconded by Ginder to approve the July minutes as presented.

Treasurer Leeseberg discussed with the board the Treasurer's reports thru July 31st 2016. She noted the expenses and the deposits. She balances with the Clerk and the bank.

Supervisor Brege noted to Treasurer Leeseberg that the trailer park was aware they owed the township for \$3.00 a trailer and were willing to start paying. He asked if she could invoice them. Cindy noted they knew they were to pay and shouldn't need an invoice and she doesn't know how many trailers they have to even invoice them. Adam will contact them and follow up on it.

COMMITTEE OR OFFICER REPORTS:

Zoning administrator Brege updated the board and said he had one new land use permit for last month. He also noted that there was not any new progress on the Trask Lake Road blight issues.

Supervisor Brege noted that the board needs to look into Board of Review alternates. It will be discussed at the next meeting.

Election Update: There were 118 voters for the Primary Election and everything went well.

COMMUNICATIONS:

- Farmland development rights agreement from Michael and Deanna Morrison was sent to the township for their records and will be placed on file.

BUSINESS:

Supervisor Brege discussed a matter of the Cemetery. Sexton Schram has been notified that a grave that was done in 2007 was put in the wrong place. It is outside of the deeded gravesite. There was some discussion on it. He will contact Sara at Gilles to see the process of how a grave could be dug up and moved to the correct spot. It was done prior to Barb with the prior Cemetery Sexton who worked for the township at that time. He will also contact Mr. Armstrong and let him know that the township is working on fixing the gravesite.

Motion by Leeseberg, seconded by Goddard to approve payment of the bills in the amount of \$6,125.62 check numbers 9316-9333.
