The Regular Meeting of the Gustin Township Board was called to order in the Village of Lincoln, July 16, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. by Supervisor Goddard.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Barb Bruski, Trustee for the Alcona County Library Board passed out a pamphlet about the millage proposal for the Library. It is a renewal only and not an increase. Missy Cordes passed out a pamphlet and introduced herself. She is currently the Register of Deeds and will be running on the ballot this August 7<sup>th</sup> on the Republican ticket. Rod Cordes, chairman for the 911 committee passed out a pamphlet on the 911 millage. It is for a ¼ mil and is a new millage. They are looking to raise \$180,000 or a little more. Adam Brege, County Commissioner reported this Wednesday July 18<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm in the Alcona High School Auditorium they will be having a forum to ask questions about the upcoming millages on the ballot. He would like the board to educate the people they speak to on the Primary ballot and how it works. The people cannot split the ticket and they will have to vote for one political party. He also wants the board to let the people know they need to get out and vote.
