Motion by Brege, seconded by Somers to approve the agenda as presented. MOTION CARRIED

Motion by Somers, seconded by Brege to approve the Budget Hearing Minutes and the March minutes as presented. MOTION CARRIED

Treasurer Somers discussed with the board the March 31, 2026 Treasurer’s report. The Treasurer balances with the bank and the clerk. He has also settled with the County for 2025.
